## 2nd International EUGAIN Summer Training School: Research Recharge

### **Call for Participation**

Join us in Rome from **June 14–15th** for the 2nd International EUGAIN Summer Training School (EUGAIN-STS 2023) since summer is the ideal time to renew your enthusiasm for research!

**EUGAIN** is a COST action that aims to improve gender balance in informatics by creating and strengthening a truly multicultural European network of academics working at the forefront of the efforts in their countries, institutions, and research communities. EUGAIN Summer Schools is one of the steps that EUGAIN has taken to achieve this goal. The theme of this year is **Research Recharge**. Research Recharge will focus on research methodology and soft skills essential to support and foster **gender studies in Informatics**. Participants will develop knowledge, skills, and competencies about qualitative and quantitative research methodology; thus, while the participants gain knowledge, skills, and competencies in designing a study, they will also have the opportunity to make connections on how to use this knowledge and skills in gender and gender sensitive studies in the field of informatics. In addition, they will be more aware of methodological limitations, familiarize themselves with the process leading to article submission, and better understand the importance and role of soft skills. They are expected to work in groups and engage with data sets produced by EUGAIN existing studies and initiatives in practical hands-on activities led by keynote speakers to exchange and share ideas.

Time is also allocated to discussing individual doctoral projects and research, especially about gender and gender-sensitive studies in informatics; in these sessions, researchers can share their research ideas, establish new collaborations, and get feedback from experts and peers.

We invite doctoral and post-doctoral researchers to apply by sending their applications as specified below. The application is open to everyone interested in the topic of the Training School and working in the field of gender studies in Informatics. Registration is free and includes participation in all lectures, social events, meals, and coffee breaks. Grants to support travel and accommodation are also available.

Candidates should fill the registration form on <a href="https://eugain.training/registration-form/">https://eugain.training/registration-form/</a>, submit a letter of motivation, CV and the short abstract of the study that they will present about the gender and the gender-sensitive studies in informatics. Doctoral students should also provide a support letter from their advisors. All the applications will be evaluated and ranked by scientific committee. Successful applicants must sign-up to the e-cost system and accept the invitation letter.

Admission to the school is on competitive grounds and selected participants are expected to attend for the **full length of the program**, from the morning of Wednesday June 14<sup>th</sup> till afternoon of Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> and contribute actively to group work. Successful applicants will be asked to









bring a poster to present their research. Upon completing the school, participants will receive a certificate of participation.
